PART 55, AIR POLLUTION CONTROL, NATURAL RESOURCES AND ENVIRONMENTAL PROTECTION ACT, 1994 PA 451, AS AMENDED. The Department intends to develop proposed revisions to the Air Pollution Control Rules (SOAHR 2009-050EQ). The proposed amendments to Part 9, Emission Limitations and Prohibitions—Miscellaneous, include replacing R 366.1931 that adopted by reference federal emission guidelines and creating a stand-alone state rule, based on the federal plan requirements, regarding landfill gas emission standards for existing municipal solid (MSW) landfills; rescinding R 336.1932 that adopts by reference a previous version of the emission guidelines for existing MSW combustors; and adding R 336.1948 and R 336.1949, which respectively would prevent the introduction of contaminants to electric arc furnaces and the steel-making process.
