FY 2009 MDOT CONSTRUCTION CONTRACTING ACTIVITIES

BID LETTING

During FY 2009, MDOT received 5,246 bids from 363 different bidders for 878 projects in 23 bid lettings. State Trunkline projects comprised 445 of the total projects let. The remaining projects were 398 Local, 34 Aeronautics and 1 Freight Services. State Trunkline projects represented 50.7% of the total number of projects processed.

The total dollar amount for State Trunkline projects during FY 2009 was \$1,068.7 million of the total low bid dollars of \$1,387.9, or 77.0%. For FY 2008, \$888.5 million of \$1,260.6 million in total low bid dollars were State Trunkline projects. The total low bid dollars for State Trunkline projects increased 16.9% in FY 2009 compared to FY 2008. The low bid total for the remaining projects during FY 2009 was \$319.2 million. The above data excludes projects where all bids were rejected.

REJECTIONS AND APPEALS

There were two low bid rejections during fiscal year 2009. Each of the two construction bidders submitted an incomplete test bid and neglected to withdraw the bid prior to the bids being downloaded. There were no low bid appeals during FY 2009.

All bids were rejected on seven projects during FY 2009, or 0.80%, of the 878 projects let. Four of the seven were State Trunkline. One of the four State projects was classified as "All bids withdrawn" after bids were received. Each bidder of this project item did not comply with the DBE Solicitation Good Faith Effort notice to bidders.

The low bidders of seven projects withdrew from performing work. Five of the seven low bidders were unable to obtain bonding. The second low bidder was awarded the contracts in each of the seven projects.

PREQUALIFICATION

At the end of fiscal year 2009, 846 construction contractors were prequalified. Of this number, 170 individual prequalified contractors were awarded prime contracts. For fiscal year 2008, 183 individual contractors were awarded prime contracts of the 739 prequalified construction contractors. Ten prime contractors were awarded 59.4% of the total low bid dollar amount in fiscal year 2009, compared to 47.8% for fiscal year 2008.

PAYMENTS

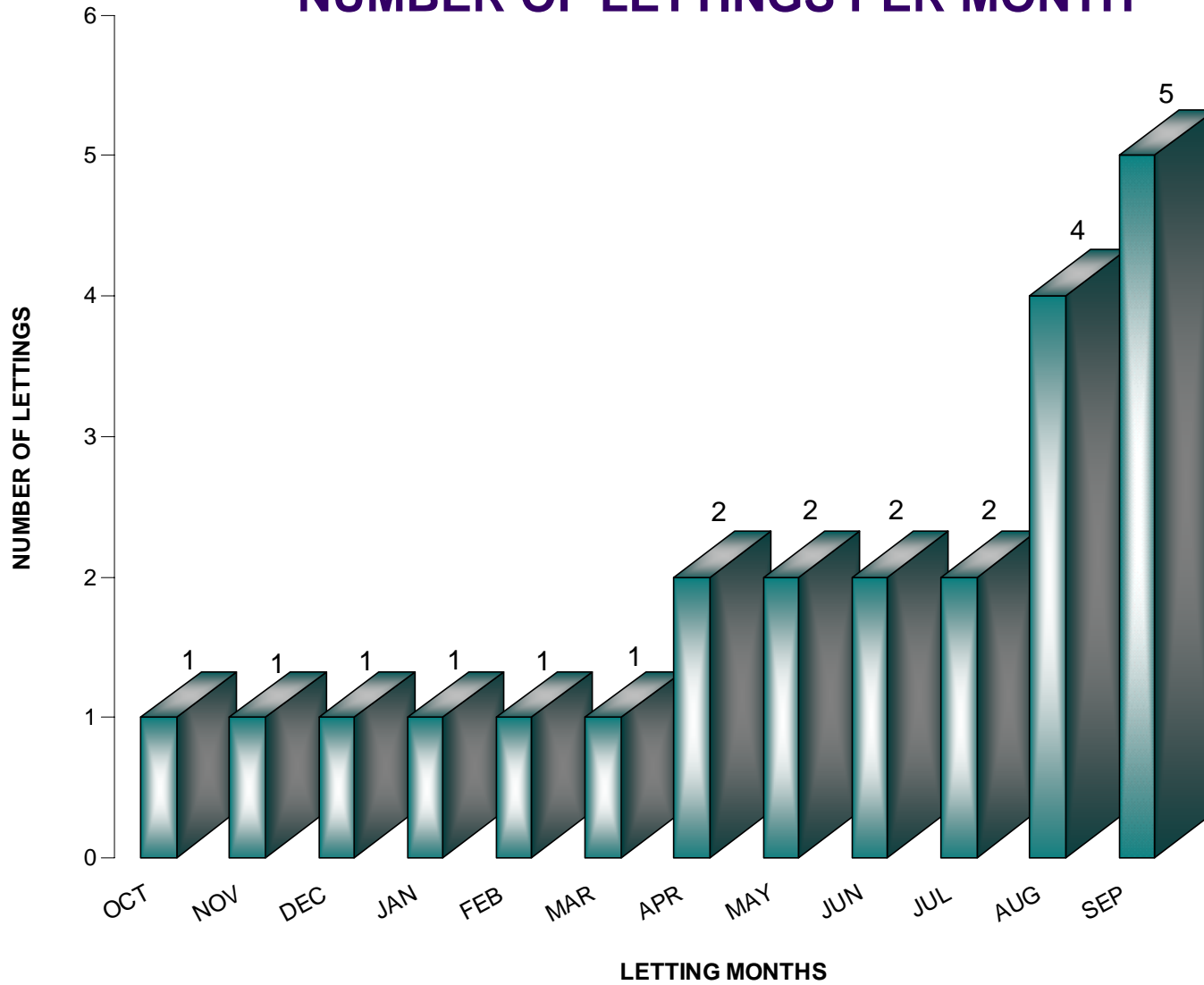
During the 2009 fiscal year, 13,201 payment estimates were processed totaling \$1,270.6 million paid to contractors.

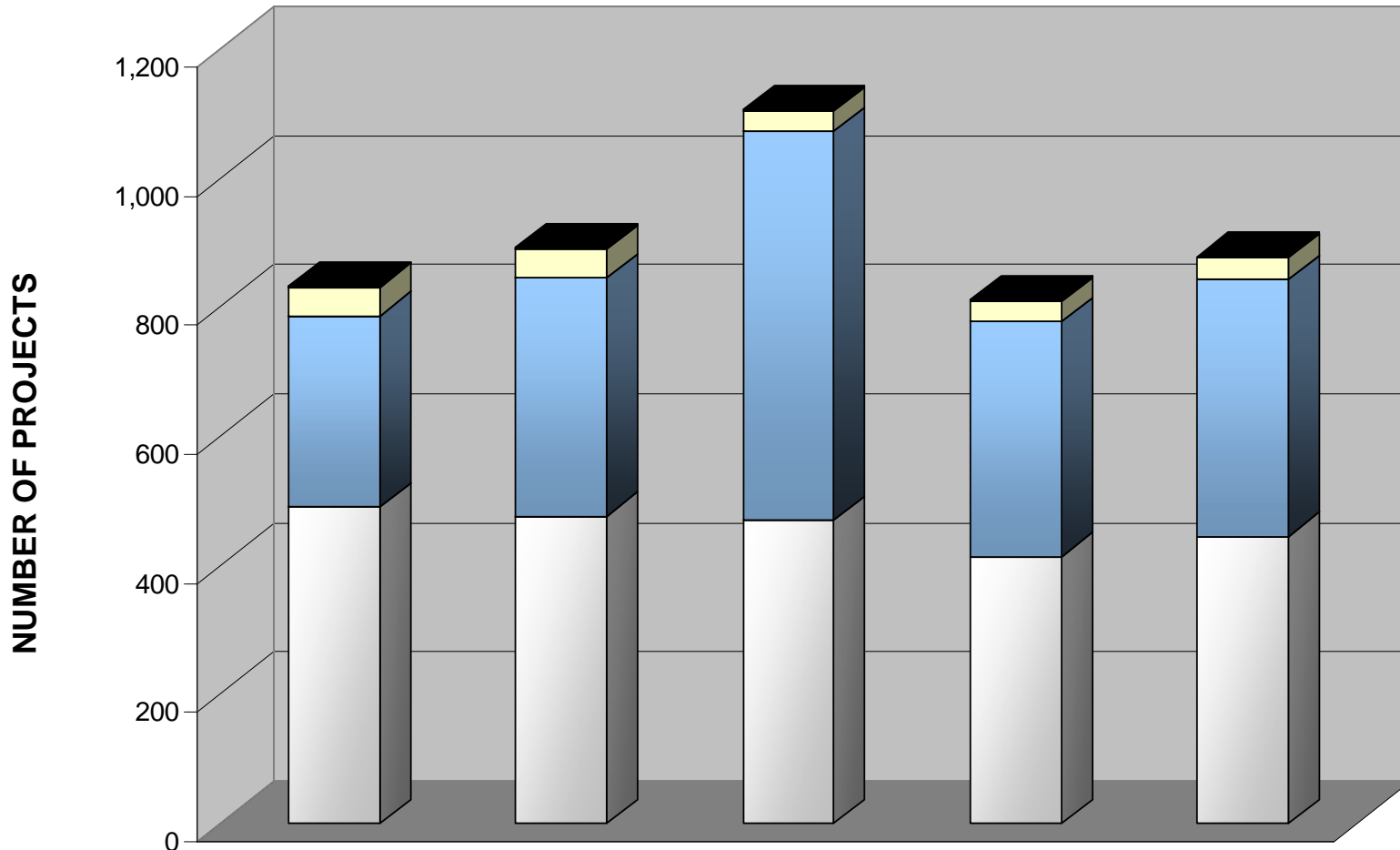
NUMBER OF LETTINGS PER MONTH

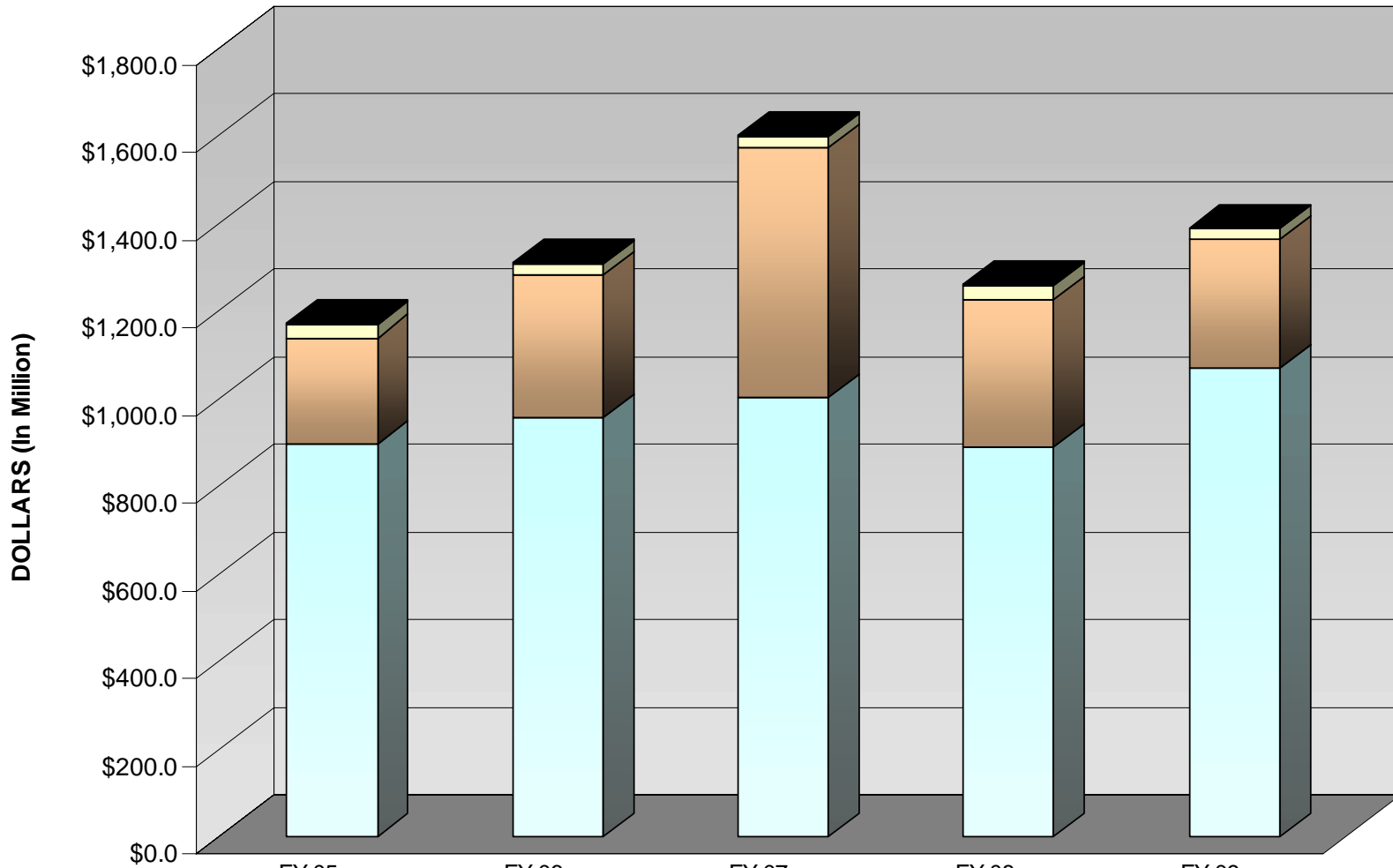

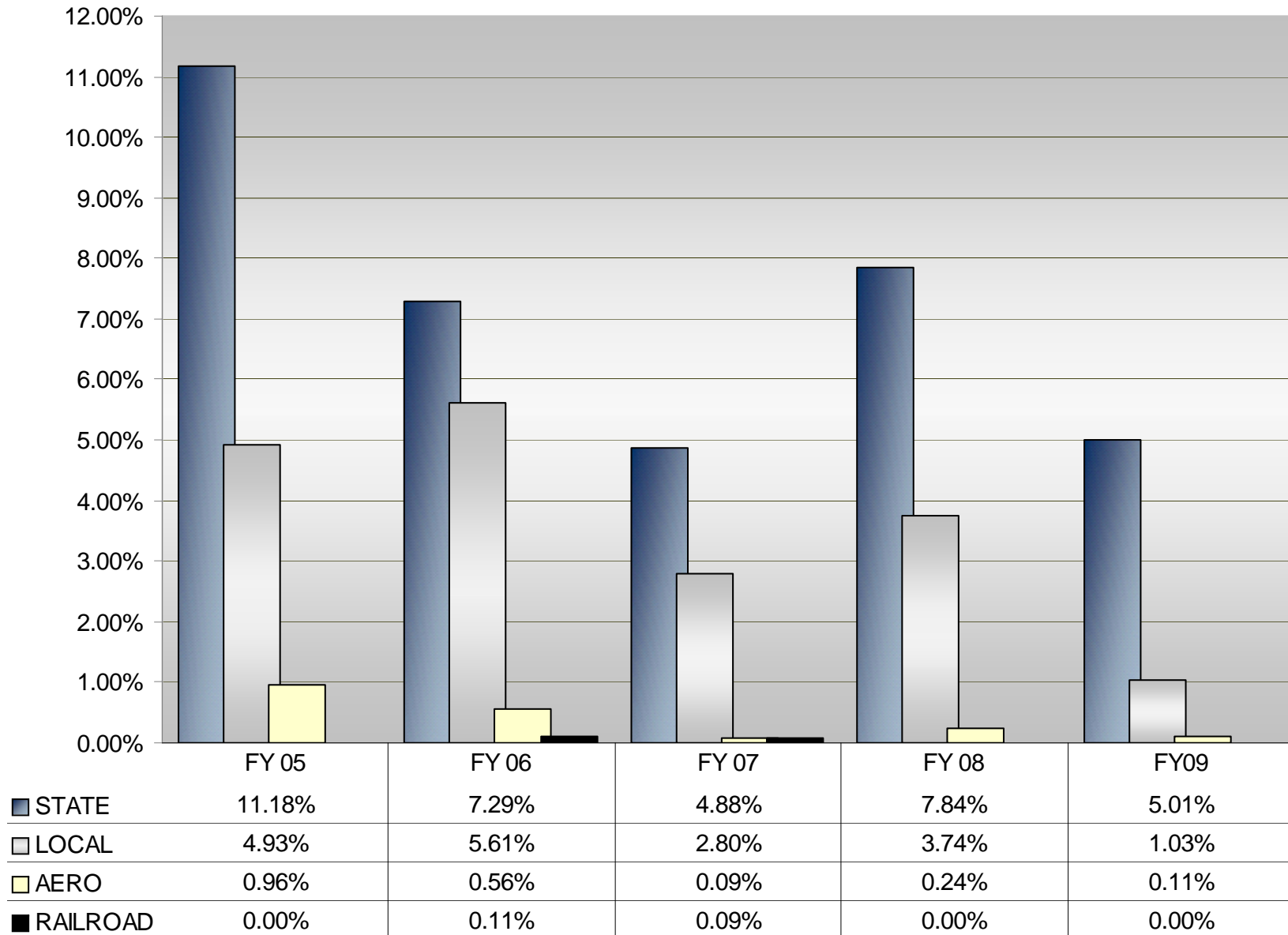
PROJECTS BY PROGRAM AREA

LOW BID DOLLARS (In Million)



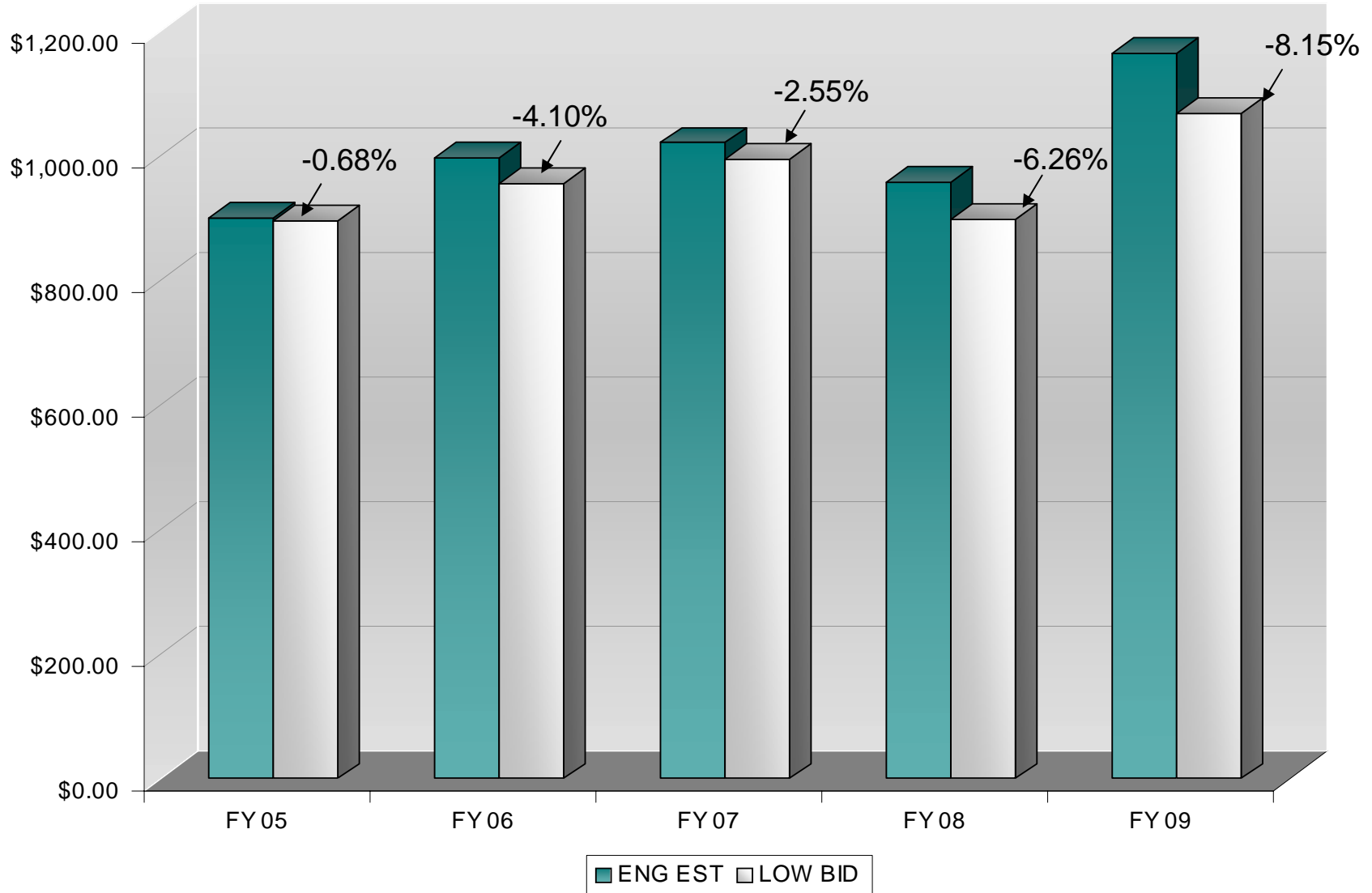

PERCENT OF PROJECTS 10% OVER ENGINEERS' ESTIMATES



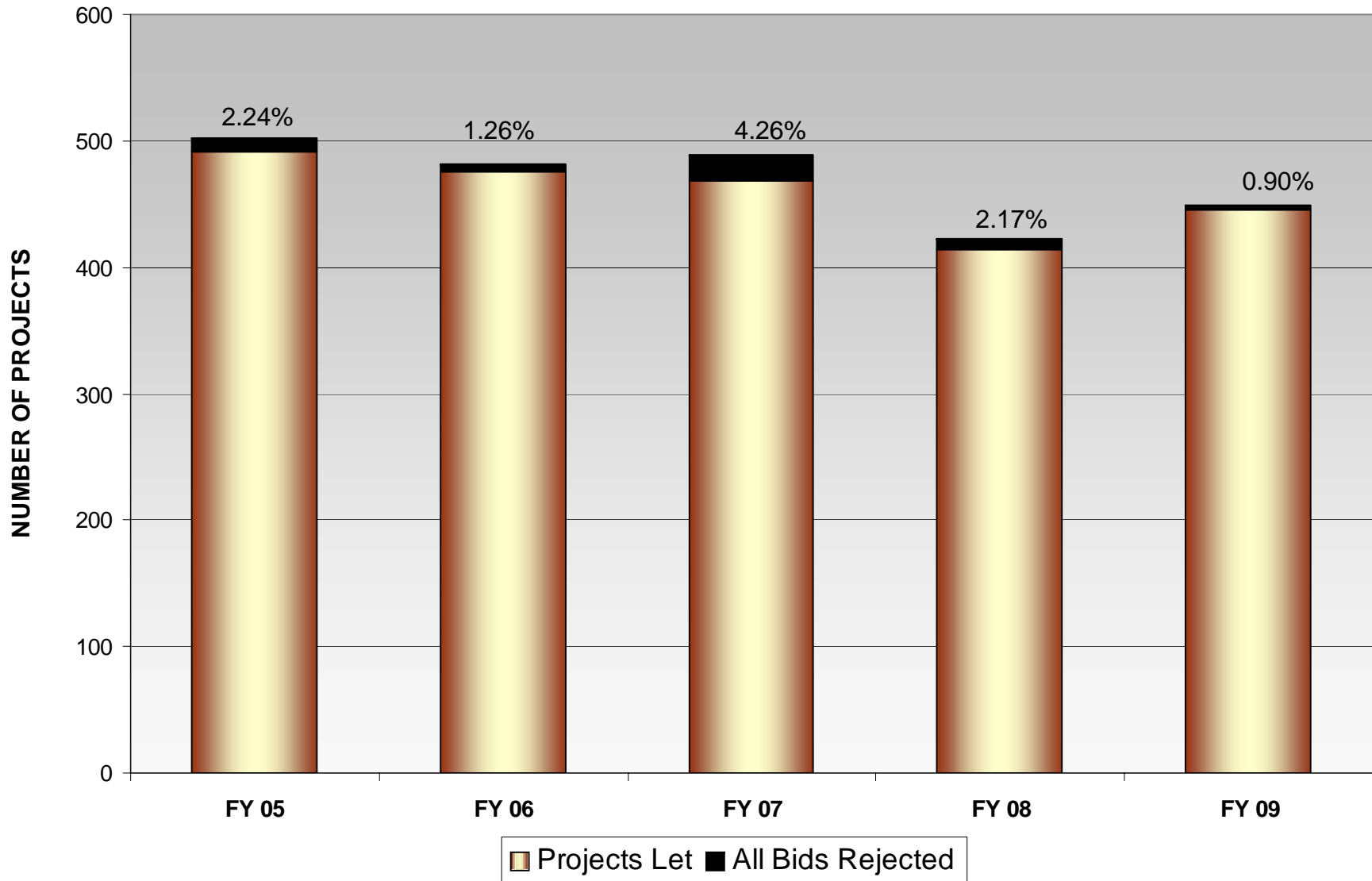
LOW BIDS vs. ENGINEERS' ESTIMATES

STATE PROJECTS



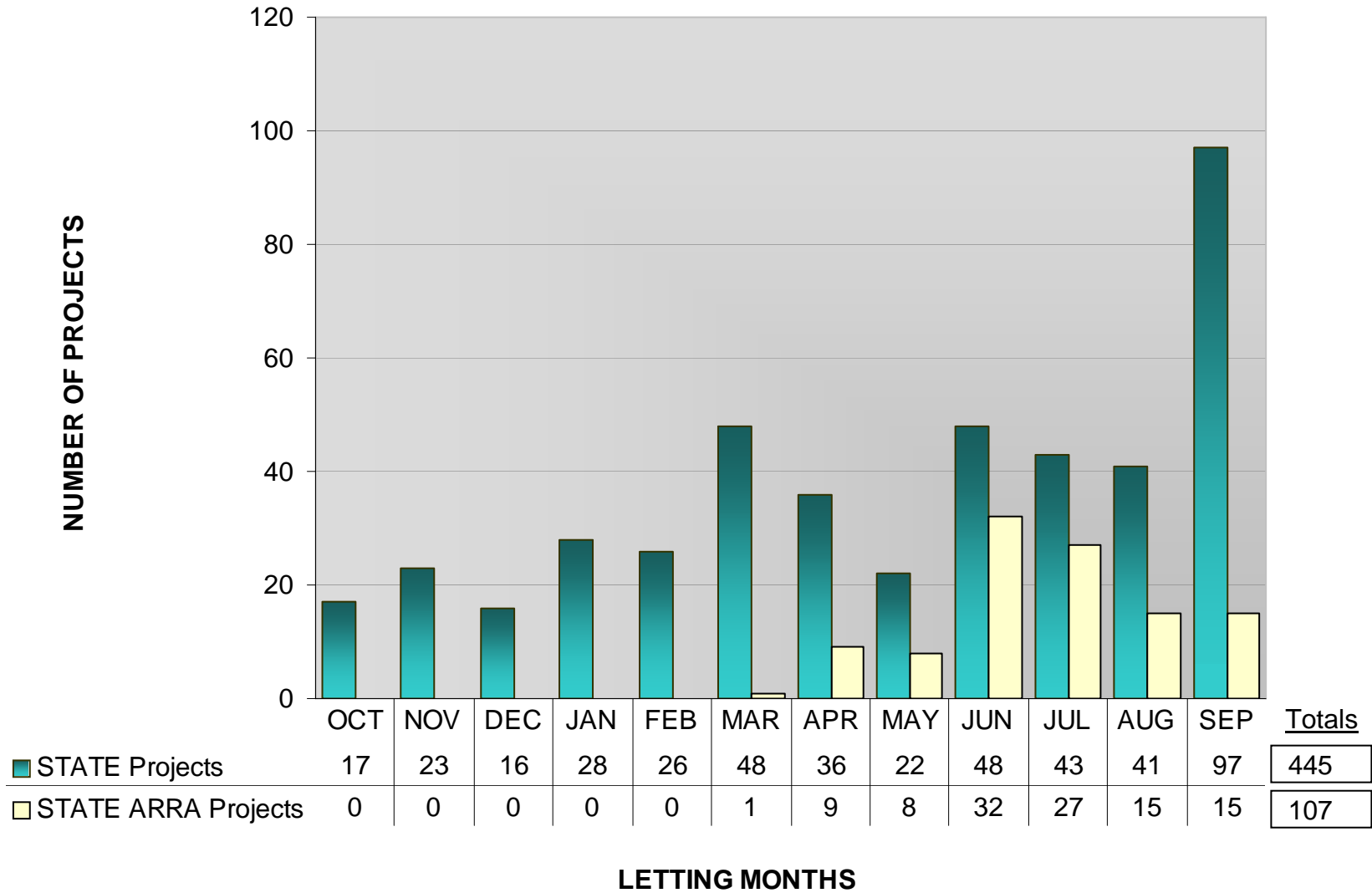
STATE PROJECTS vs ALL BIDS REJECTED

5 YEAR COMPARISON



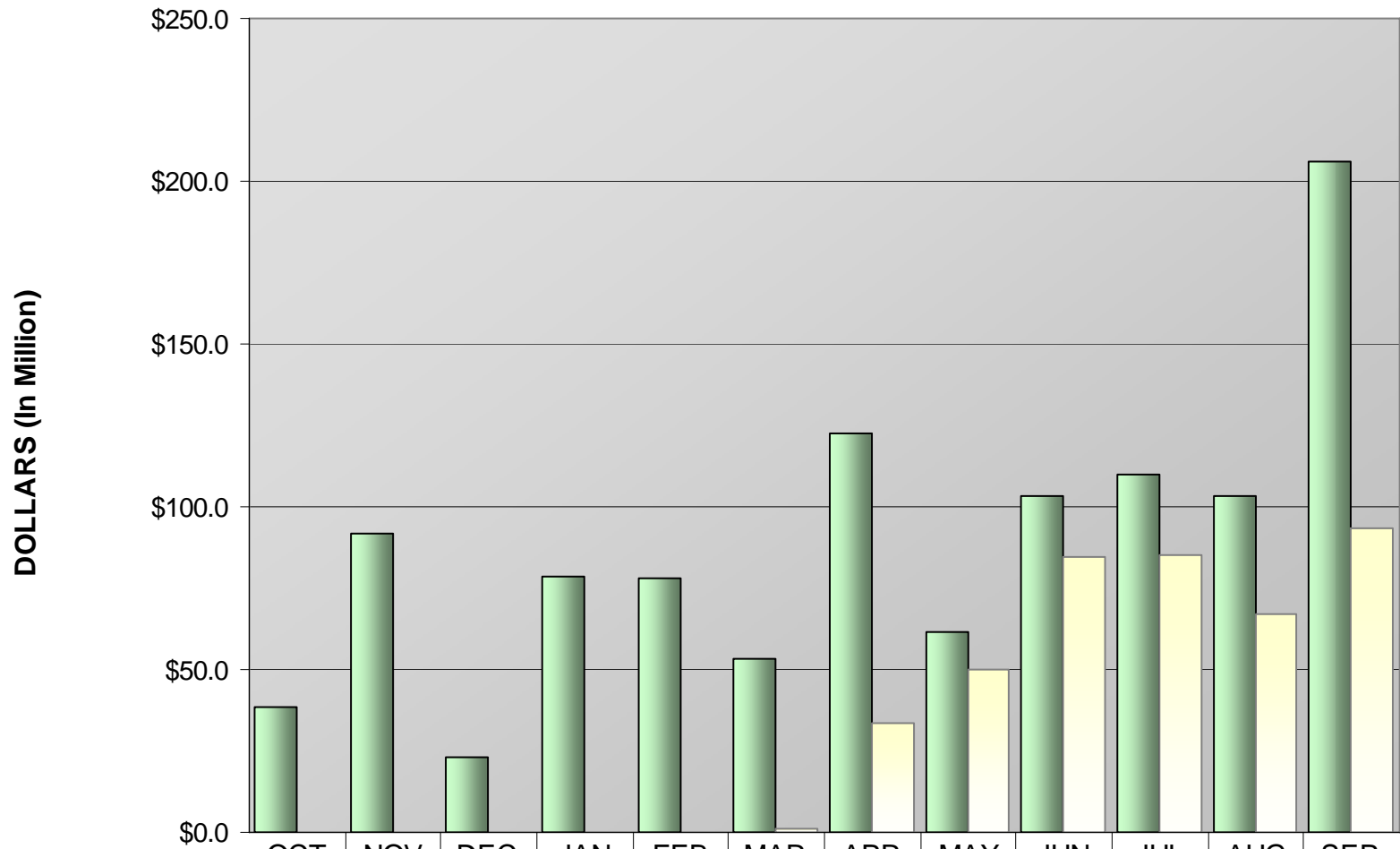
STATE PROJECTS vs. STATE ARRA PROJECTS

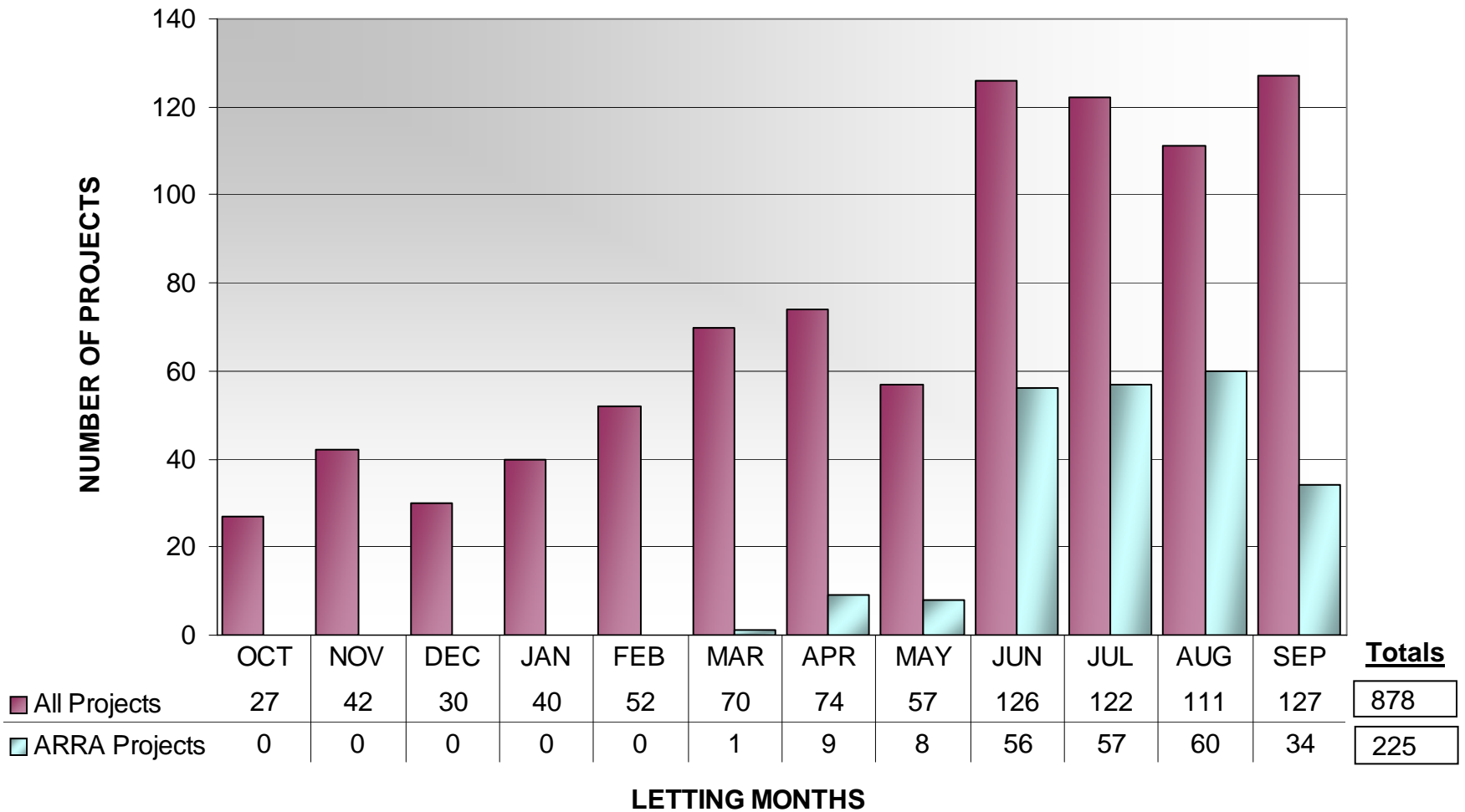

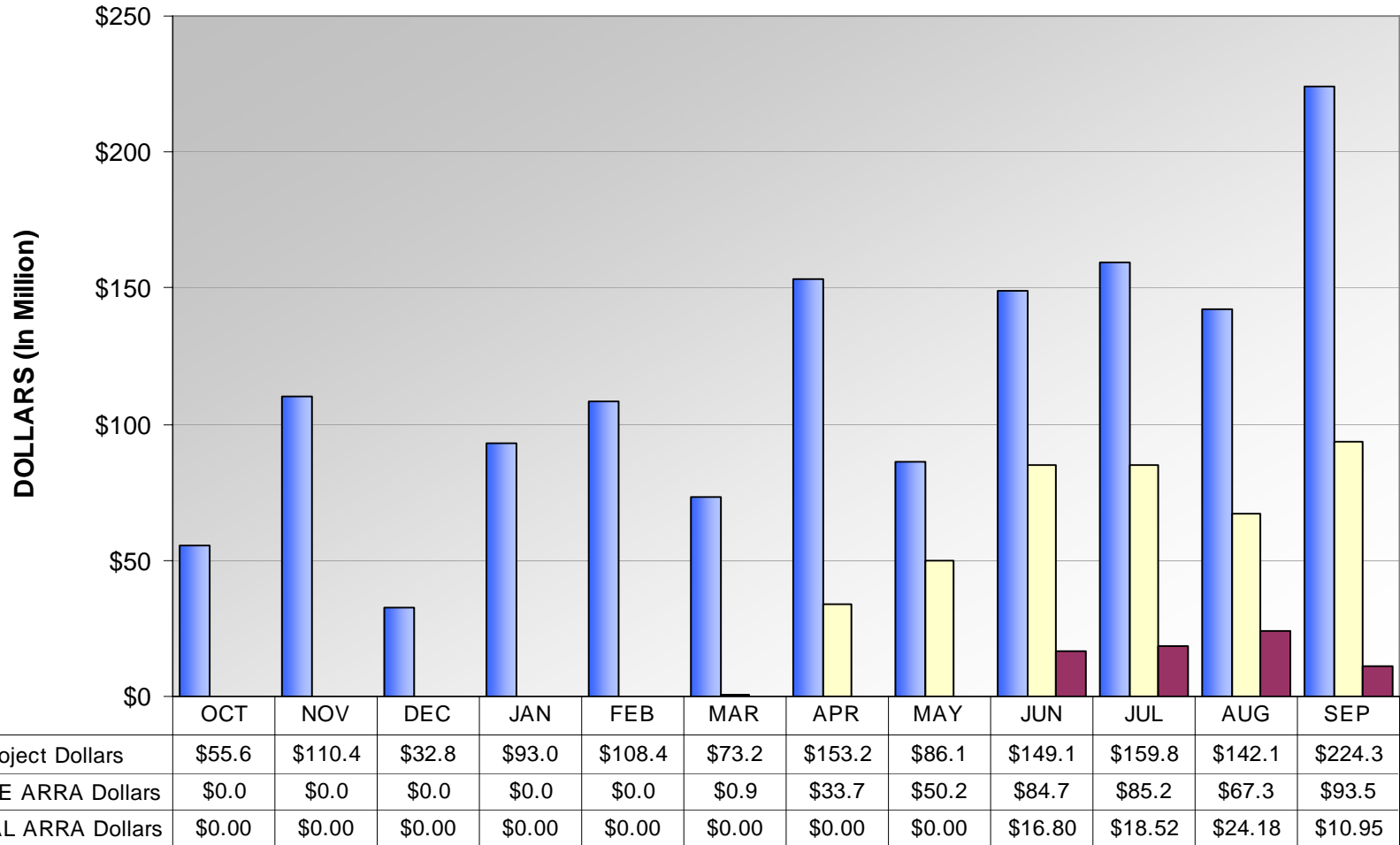

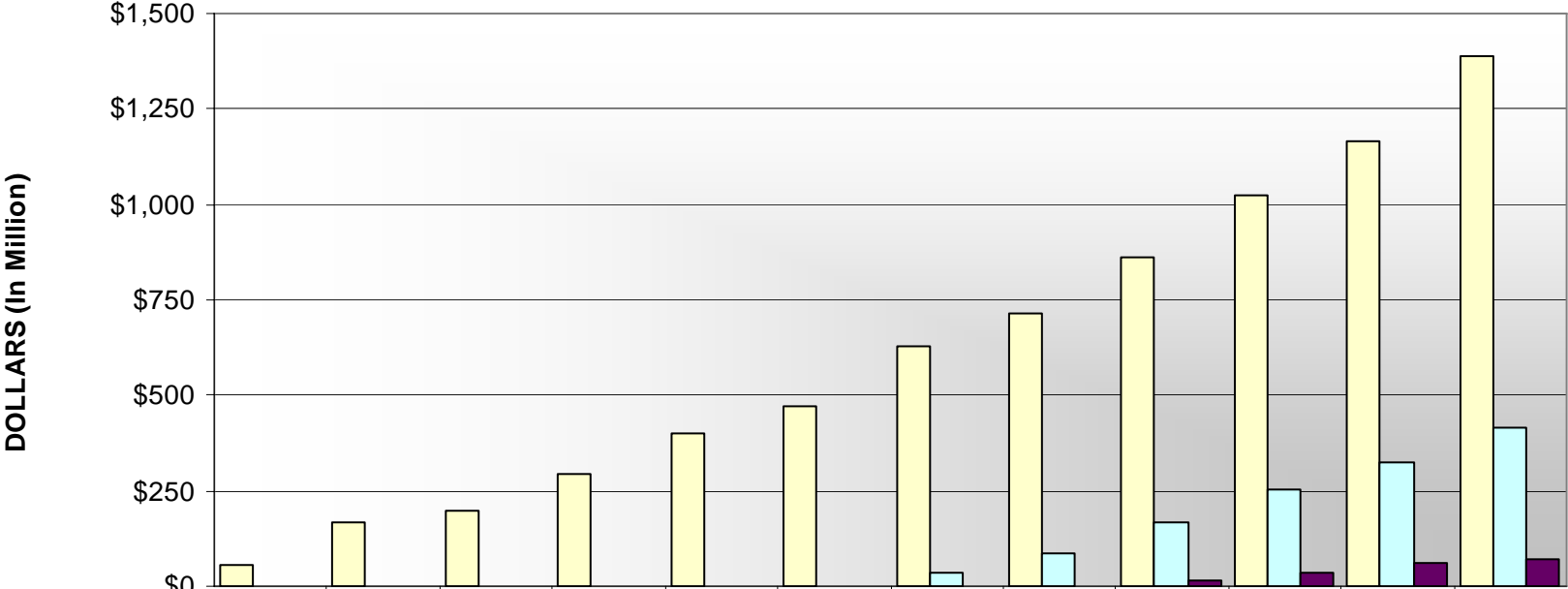
DOLLARS per LETTING MONTH

CUMULATIVE DOLLARS - Fiscal Year 2009

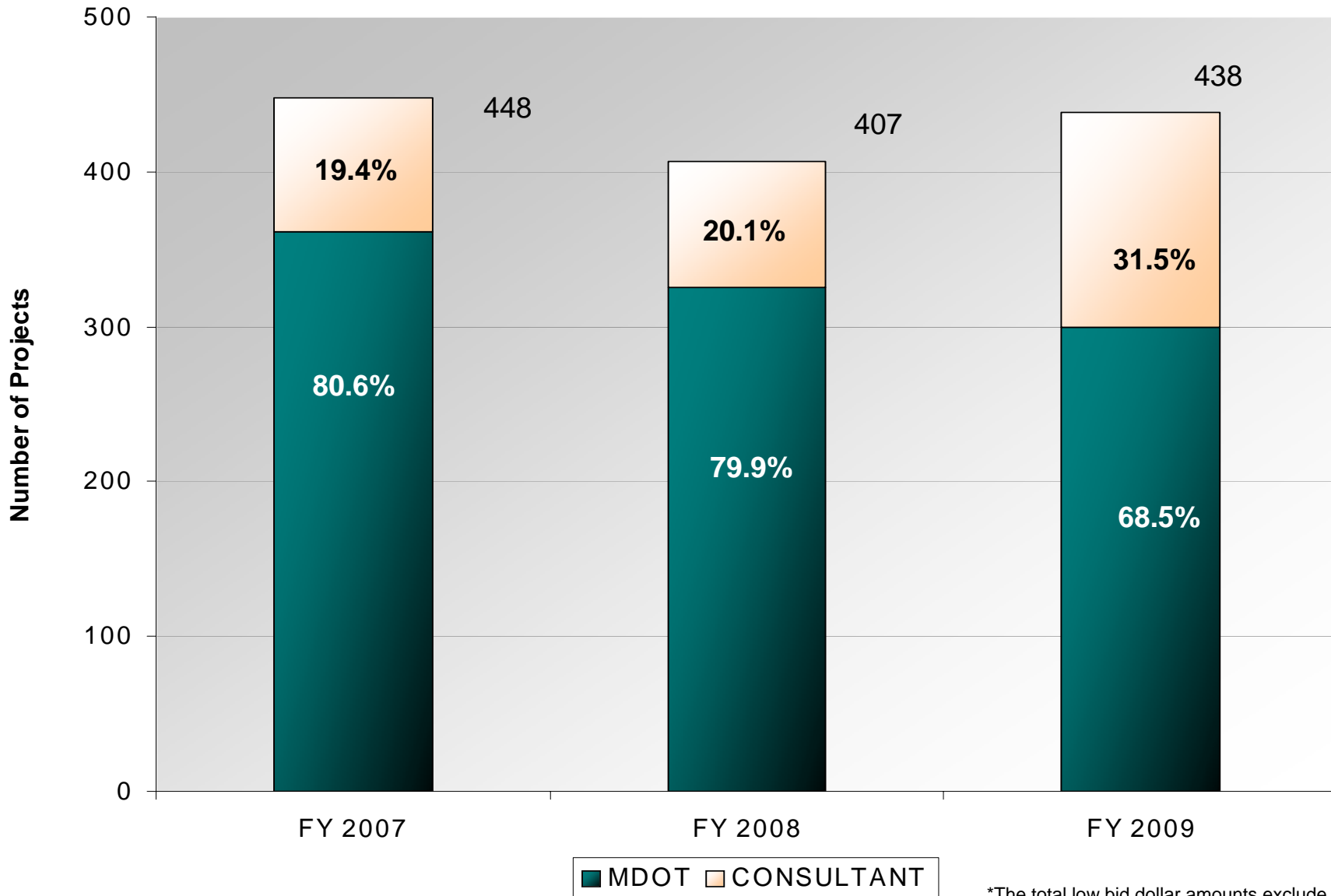

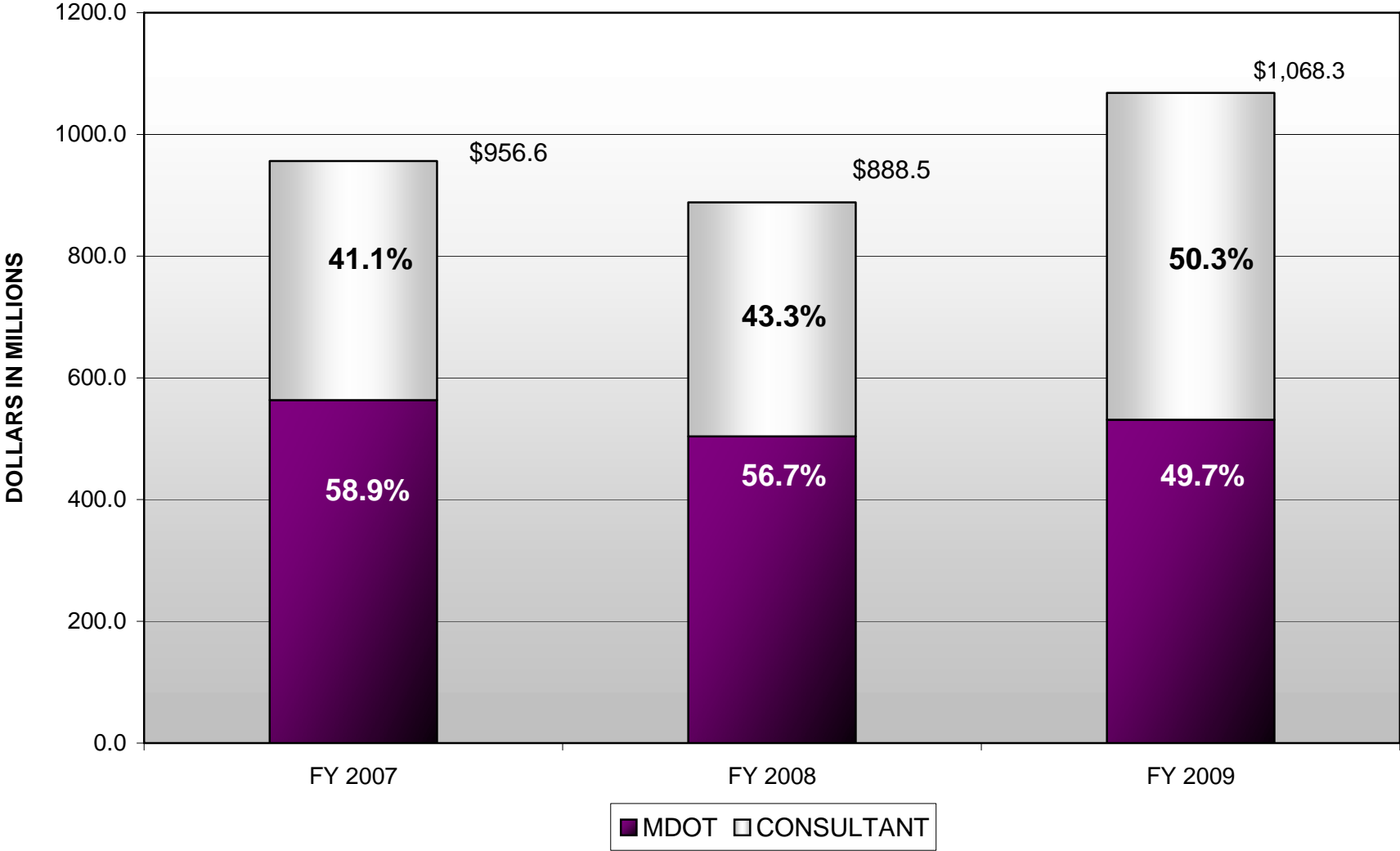

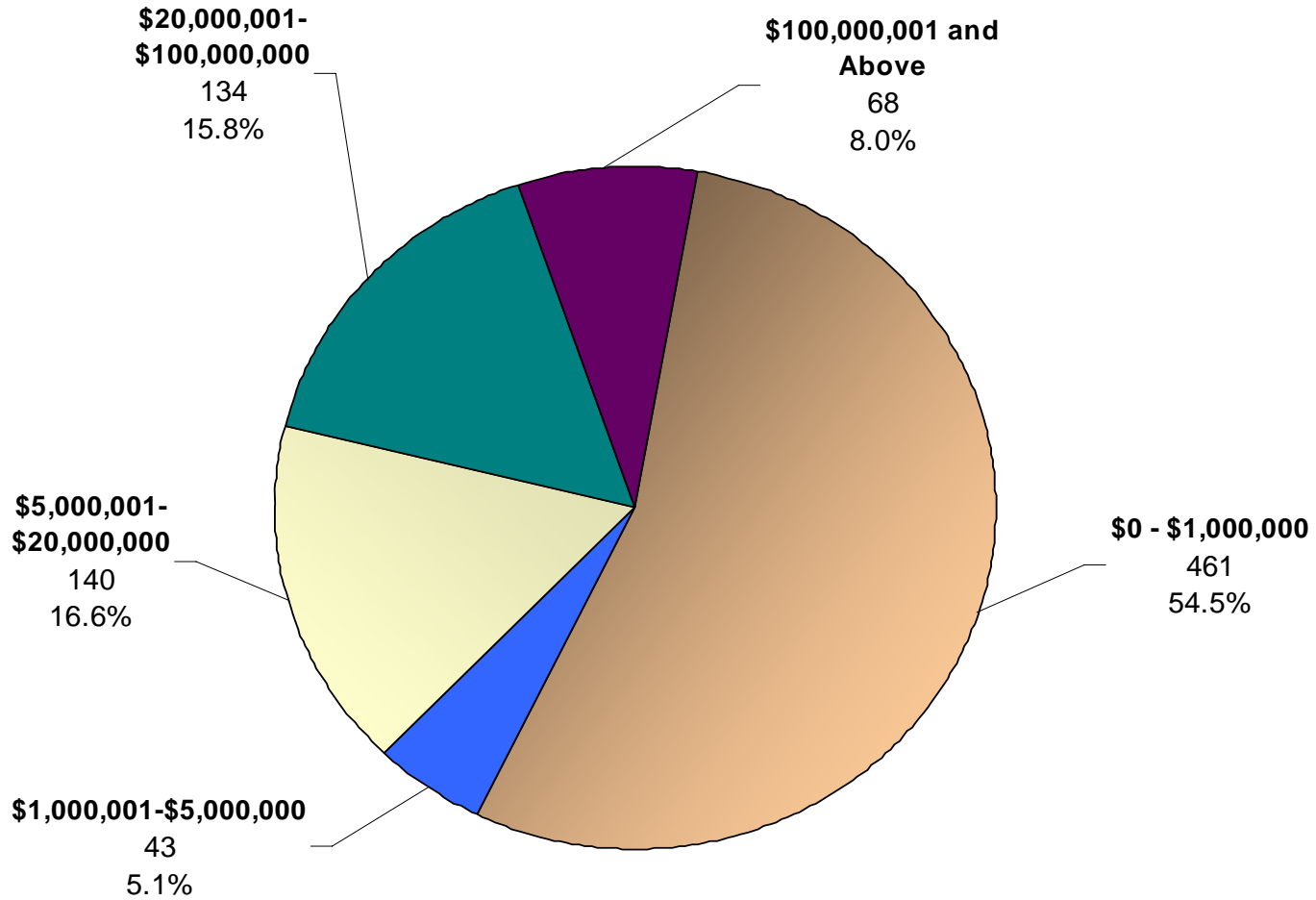
LOW BID DOLLAR AMOUNT*

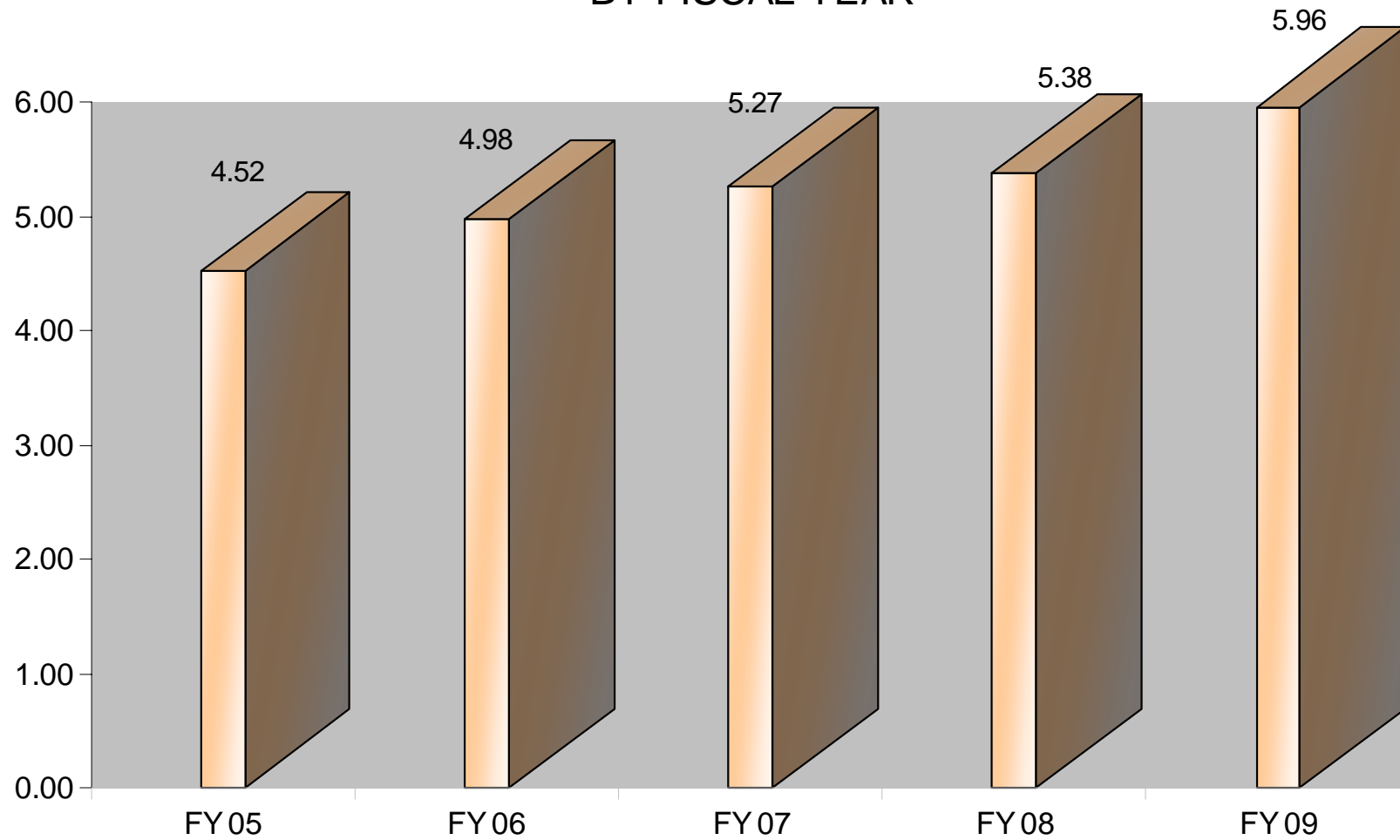
FINANCIAL STATISTICS

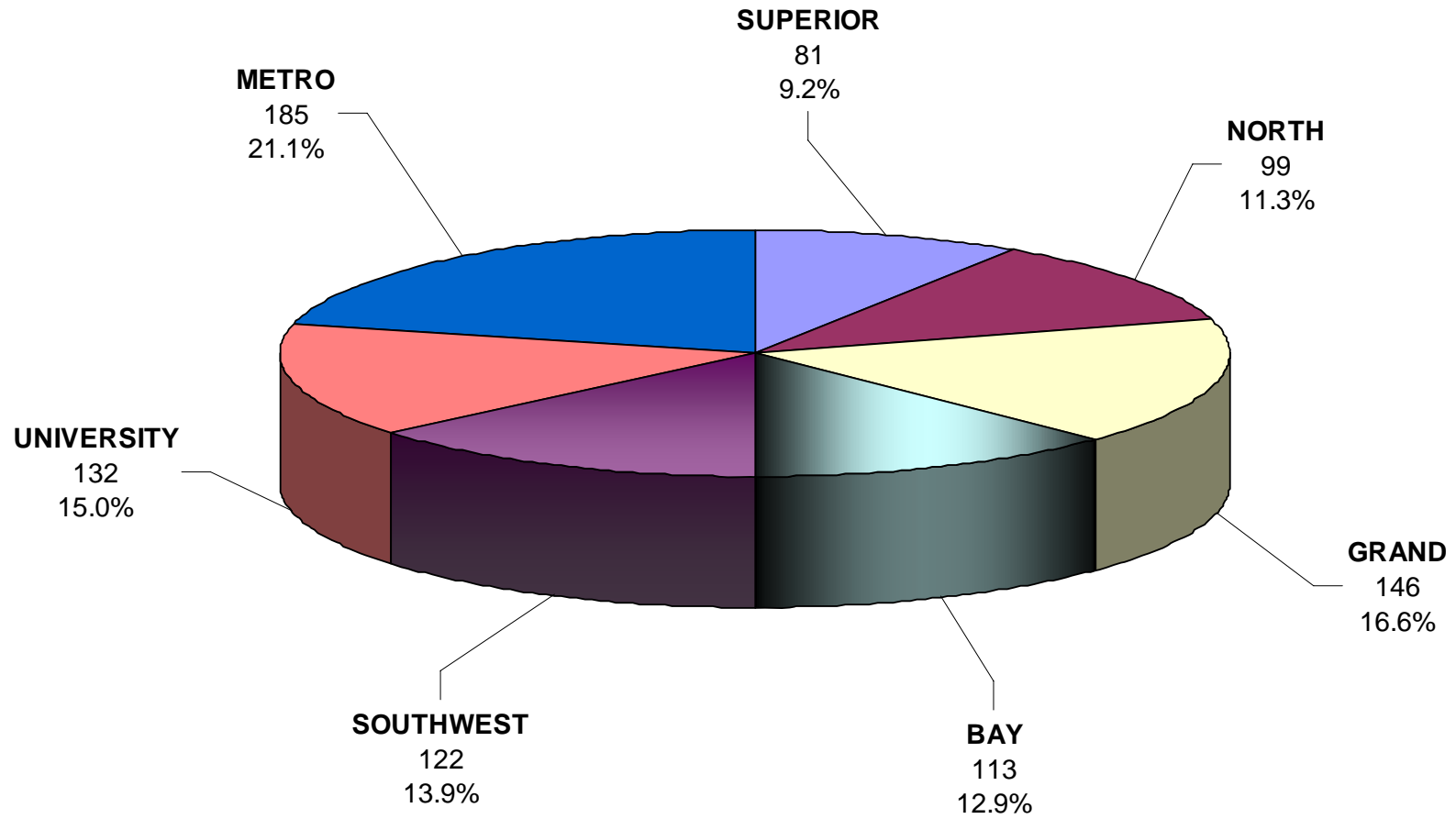

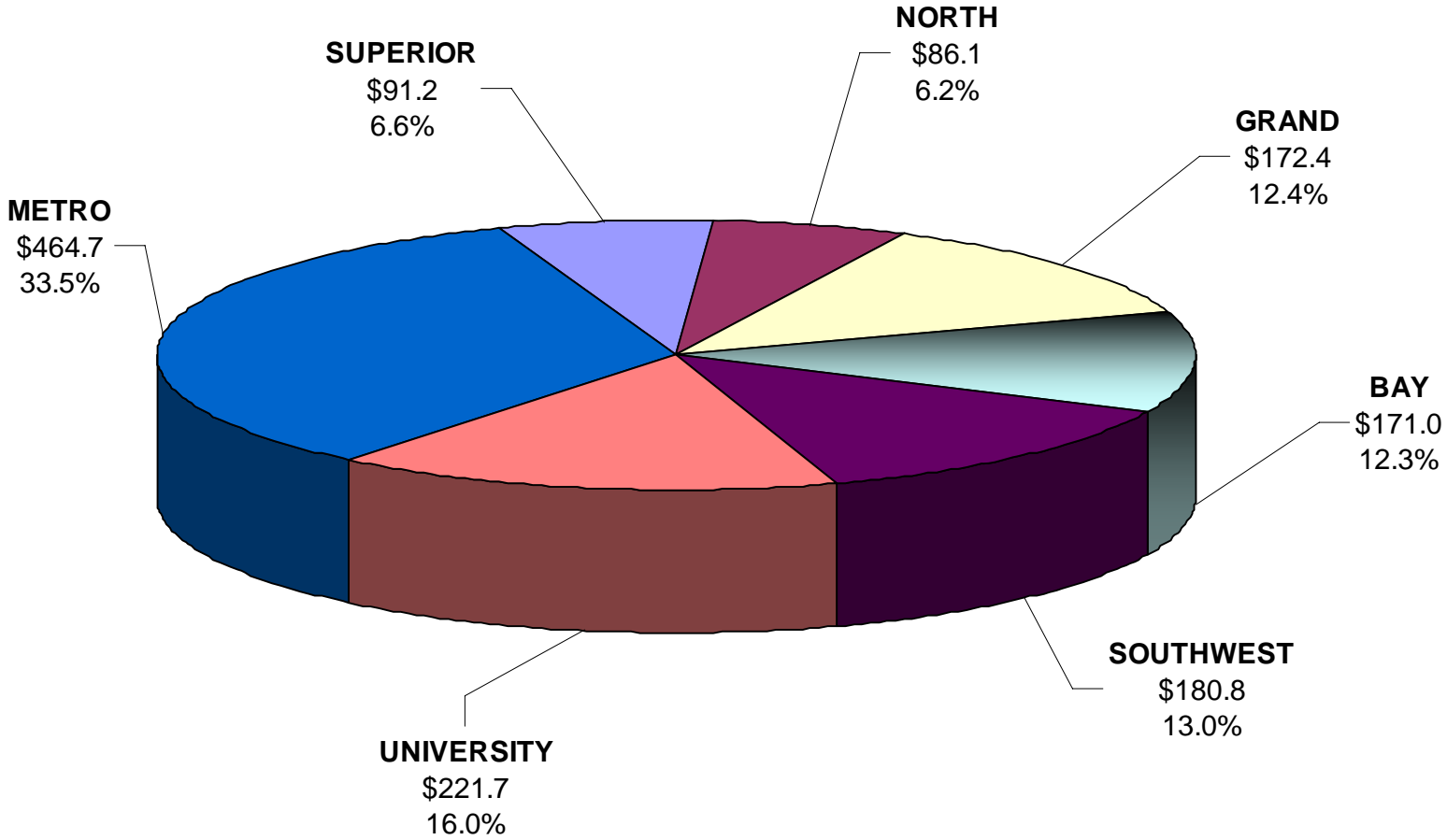
CONTRACTS BY REGION
